

PUBLIC NOTICE
MEETING RELATED TO THE BASIN-WIDE PLAN
FOR JOINT INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT
OF OVERAPPROPRIATED PORTIONS
OF THE PLATTE RIVER BASIN, NEBRASKA

The Central Platte Natural Resources District, North Platte Natural Resources District, South Platte Natural Resources District, Tri-Basin Natural Resources District, Twin Platte Natural Resources District (collectively, the Platte Basin NRDs), and the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources (Department) hereby provide notice that a public meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 27, 2010, at 1:00 p.m. CDT, at the Gothenburg Water Utilization Learning Center, 76268 Highway 47, Gothenburg, Nebraska. The purpose of the meeting is to review progress toward achieving the goals and objectives of the Basin-Wide Plan and the portions of individual NRD integrated management plans (IMPs) that implement the Basin-Wide Plan. The agenda will include discussions of: 1) revisions to the Basin-Wide Plan; 2) revisions to the individual IMPs; 3) new data and information; 4) reports of ongoing monitoring of actions taken by the NRDs and the Department; 5) a public comment period; and 6) disputes related to implementation of the IMPs.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and comment during the public comment period. Additionally, any groundwater user, surface water appropriator, NRD, or the Department may send a written request to one of the Platte Basin NRDs or the Department for revision to the Basin-Wide Plan by the close of business June 28, 2010. Persons sending a written request for changes to the Basin-Wide Plan will be given the opportunity for input during the public meeting. Groundwater users, surface water appropriators, the Platte Basin NRDs, and the Department may also present data and other supporting information at the annual meeting identifying disputes between groundwater users and surface water appropriators.
